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

keeping YOU safe.

What Can You Do If You're Uncomfortable?

- Offer a fist bump or high five instead.
- Turn sideways and give them a side hug.
- Stick out your hand and offer a handshake.
- Be honest. Say how you feel in a strong voice.





In the story, Flamingo Hugs, Flaminga achieves her goal of getting a hug. She thinks it is the best day EVER! What would happen on your best day?





Design Your Own Petting Zoo Name:





